The Bihar State Hydro Electric Power Corporation Ltd. Invites separate bids for each group through e-tendering for “Completion of balance Electro-Mechanical works” of following 11 (eleven) under construction projects in different districts of Bihar from interested, reputed & experienced firms/contractors/developers. Bids shall have to be submitted in two parts i.e. Part-I (Technical & Commercial) and Part-II (Price) of each group separately. The respective estimated cost, EMD, cost of tender documents and tender processing fee for each group is also shown in following table: -

1.0 SCOPE OF THE CONTRACT

The scope of work under the contract includes following (upto LV side of Power Transformer) for successful commissioning and operation of the project:

- (i) Design & Supply of balance equipment required for the project.
- (ii) To check and furnish the list of equipment/ material, which were supplied/erected by the earlier executing agency but became faulty/obsolete/unserviceable during the intervening long period along with the estimated cost and list of vendors for speedy purchase. This list of such equipment shall be verified /approved by the joint committee comprising of BHPCL & agency. Replacement (if any) shall be as per BHPCL instructions.

- (iii) Servicing of already supplied/ erected equipment (functional) including dismantling, cleaning, polishing, replacement of grease and other lubricants, replacement of all seals and re-assembly alignment.
- (iv) Erection, Testing and commissioning of complete unit(s).
- (v) The works are to be carried out in conformity with progress of works carried out by other agencies.
- (vi) Performance guarantee/security of newly supplied items in the power house to be provided upto guarantee period.
- (vii) Operation and maintenance of the project for 3 (three) months post commissioning.

2.0 COMPLETION PERIOD

The completion period for this work is 9 months from the effective date of contract PLUS Operation & Maintenance of the project for 3 months post-commissioning.

3.0 SITE VISIT

Before submitting the offer, bidders are required to visit the project site (at their own cost) to get themselves fully acquainted with actual site conditions and have complete idea of the scope of balance works. No payment shall be made against such visit and pre assessment.

4.0 QUALIFYING CRITERIA

E-tender is open to all Companies/Corporations/limited concerns/registered firms/ reputed contractors who meet with the following qualifying criteria:

1. Manufactures of E&M equipment for Hydro Power Plants capacity 0.5 MW and above since last 5 years.
Or

Have experience in developing, constructing & commissioning of minimum 10 MW aggregate capacity of Hydro Electric Power projects during last 10 years.

Or

Have executed similar type of works on at least three projects during last 10 years of total contract value 15 (Fifteen) Crores and above.

2. The bidders must be registered under the Indian Companies Act or under the laws of Bihar State or equivalent within legal framework of State/Govt. of India.
3. The bidder/their sub-contractor/one of the Consortium Partner (or one of the constituents firms of the JV) should be Registered Electrical Contractor having valid H.T. Contractor License.
4. The bidder must be registered under EPF and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 along with ESI, IT, Labour and GST etc.
5. The bidders must be an overall profit making company and having the minimum average annual turn-over (MAAT) for following projects group wise during three financial years 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19: -

In case the firm bids for those projects in addition to this project then, required minimum average annual turn-over shall be cumulative for those bidders who have quoting lowest for other group.

6. Bids (Technical as well as Price) shall be valid for a period of **180 (one hundred eighty) days** from the day Techno-commercial bids are opened (Self Declaration). A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected.
7. Joint Venture/Consortium are also eligible to participate in the tenders, having following eligibility criteria:-
 - (i) Joint Venture:
 - a) Each firms of the joint venture must be an overall profit making company during last three years and registered under company act.
 - b) The share of a company in such Joint Venture shall not be less than 30%.
 - c) The experiences (Technical/Financial) of share holders of the Joint Venture will be added together towards meeting eligibility criteria.

- d) All constituents firms of joint venture shall be jointly and severally responsible and liable for the execution of the contract as per terms and conditions of contract.
- e) The Joint Venture Company has to be registered under company act within 30 days of issue of LOI/ award of the contract.
- f) However, if the bidder is quoting against one or more project in his individual capacity, he cannot be a part of joint ventures to participate in same project as notified against this tender specification & vice versa.
- g) Work Order shall be issued in the name of joint ventures only.

(ii) Consortium:

- a) Each partners of the consortium must be an overall profit making company during last three years and registered under company act.
 - b) The number of partners in such consortium shall not be more than three.
 - c) The experiences (Technical/Financial) of partners of the Consortium will be added together towards meeting eligibility criteria
 - d) The bid shall include all the information required as described above for each partner of consortium
 - e) All partners of the consortium shall be jointly and severally responsible and liable for the execution of the contract as per terms and conditions of contract.
 - f) The lead partner and responsibility matrix among partners has to be defined and submitted duly signed by all the partners.
 - g) The lead partner must meet 40% of financial qualifying criteria (annual average turnover) and 40% of technical qualifying criteria (Experiences).
 - h) Lead partner will be responsible for all technical/ financial/ administrative communication with the corporation.
 - i) However, if the bidder is quoting against one or more project in his individual capacity, he cannot be a part of consortium to participate in same project as notified against this tender specification & vice versa.
 - j) Work Order shall be issued in favour of the Lead Partner only.
8. The agencies have to submit affidavit sworn before the Executive Magistrate that neither the bidder nor his JV/ Consortium partner (s) is/are a blacklisted contractor/company by BHPC, Bihar Govt./ State Electricity Board/Power Distribution Company of State Governments or any organization of any State or Government of India.

vii. SUBMISSION OF TENDER

1. The bidder shall submit his bid/tender on e-Procurement platform at www.eproc.bihar.gov.in.
2. The bidder must have the Class II/III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) with signing + Encryption, and User-id of the e-Procurement website before participating in the e-Tendering process. The bidder may use their DSC if they

already have. They can also take DSC from any of the authorized agencies. For user-id they have to get registered themselves on e-procurement website www.eproc.bihar.gov.in and submit their bids online on the same. Offline bids shall not be entertained by the Tender Inviting Authority for the tenders published in e-procurement platform.

3. The bidders shall submit their eligibility and qualification details, Technical bid, Financial bid etc., in the online standard formats given in e-Procurement web site at the respective stage only. The bidders shall upload the scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc., in support of their eligibility criteria / technical bids and other certificate /documents in the e-Procurement web site. The bidder shall digitally sign on the supporting statements, documents, certificates, uploaded by him, owning responsibility for their correctness / authenticity. The bidder shall attach all the required documents for the specific tender after uploading the same during the bid submission as per the tender notice and bid document.
4. All the required documents should be attached at the proper place as mentioned in the e-forms otherwise the tender of the bidder will be rejected.
5. "Bids along with necessary online payments must be submitted through e-Procurement portal www.eproc.bihar.gov.in before the date and time specified in the NIT/RFP. The department / Tendering Authority doesn't take any responsibility for the delay/Non Submission of Tender/Non Reconciliation of online Payment caused due to Non-availability of Internet Connection, Network Traffic / Holidays or any other reason"
6. The tender opening will be done online only.
7. Any corrigendum or date extension notice will be given on the e-Procurement website only.
